

## East Coast Safari

Education Queensland International's 'East Coast' Safari provides students with the opportunity to travel from Sydney to Airlie Beach while visiting some of the beautiful sights of Australia's East Coast. You will camp, visit a theme park and snorkel in the Whitsundays.



### Itinerary

#### Day 1:

- › Fly from Brisbane to Sydney
- › Visit Sydney Tower for 360 degree views of the city, including Sydney Harbour Bridge and the Opera House
- › Experience OzTrek, the largest simulated ride in Australia, with 3D holographic effects and heart stopping real motion seating
- › Lunch at own expense
- › Thrilling jet boat ride on Sydney Harbour

#### Day 2:

- › Sightseeing tour of Rose Bay and Bondi Beach
- › Lunch at own expense
- › Tour of the Opera House, Botanical Gardens, The Rocks, and Darling Harbour

#### Day 3:

- › Farewell Sydney to travel north to Port Macquarie
- › Opportunity to try surfing in the afternoon (at own expense)

- › Farewell Port Macquarie and travel north to Byron Bay
- › **Enjoy a tour of Byron Bay before setting up camp**

- › Camp at Raglan, South of Rockhampton

- › Head north through Mackay, site of the world's largest sugar handling facility
- › Arrive at Airlie Beach, sight the crystal blue waters of the Whitsunday Passage

#### Day 8:

- › Experience ocean rafting on powered boats
- › Eco guides explain the impact of the modern world on these beautiful surrounds
- › Relax on Whitehaven Beach
- › Snorkel the pristine reefs of Border Islands
- › **Explore sacred Aboriginal caves at Nara Inlet**



### Day 9:

- › Enjoy a walk through Conway Range National Park
- › **Relax by seasonal creeks, maybe spot a Ulysses butterfly or Grey Fantail bird**
- › **Free time to explore the town of Airlie Beach**

### Day 10:

- › Farewell Airlie Beach and head south to Rockhampton
- › Plenty of sight seeing opportunities along the way

### Day 11:

- › Drive through Gladstone, Bundaberg, Maryborough and Gympie before arriving on the Sunshine Coast
- › Camp on the fringes of the beach tonight

### Day 12:

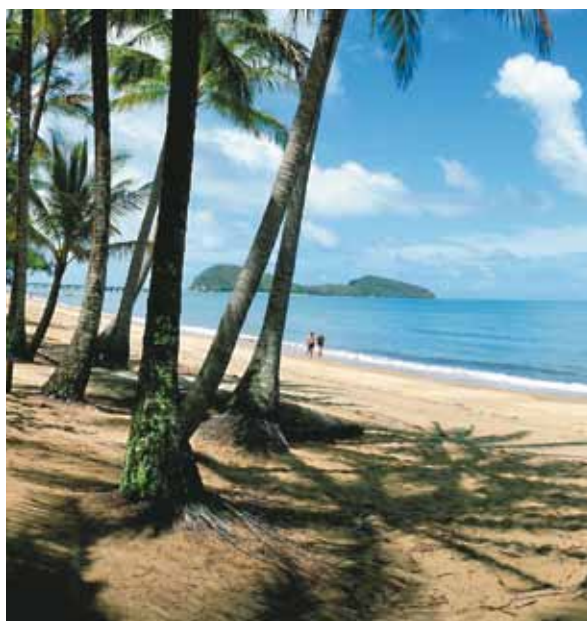
- › Farewell the Sunshine Coast and return to Brisbane
