Day 1:

- › Travel by coach to Kings Creek Station and set up camp
- › Visit the Kings Canyon and walk to the scenic rim for spectacular views over the 'Lost City' and the 'Garden of Eden'

Day 7:

- › Travel by coach to Alice Springs
- › Stop for a camel ride
- › Travel through the MacDonnell Ranges
- › Afternoon to relax
- › In the evening visit the Andrew Langford's 'Sounds of Starlight' theatre

Day 8:

- › In the morning visit the Alice Springs Desert Park and the School of the Air
- › View Heavitree Gap, Todd River and desert landscape
- › In the afternoon visit the Royal Flying Doctor Service and stop for photos at Anzac Hill
- › Lunch at own expense today
- › Visit the Alice Springs Reptile Centre

- › Set up camp at Dunmarra

- › Visit Nitmiluk National Park and go on a Katherine River Gorge cruise
