Bunyaville Environmental Education Centre (BEEC) is situated in the Bunyaville Conservation Park, in the north-western suburbs of Brisbane only 20 minutes from the city centre. The park includes dry sclerophyll forest, dry vine rainforest and freshwater ponds along seasonally flowing creeks. Bunyaville EEC provides real life learning experiences through quality environmental education for all students, teachers and community, enabling them to become active and responsible global citizens.

Our programs cater for groups from Kindergarten through to University students. The centre also partners schools in reducing their ecological footprint through educating for a sustainable future. Program focus varies from understanding healthy waterways, whole of catchment and forest conservation strategies to exploring endangered species, engaging students and teachers in the process of active citizenship within their classrooms and communities and much more.

Bunyaville Bushies

This full day program gives overseas visitors a real taste of the Australian Bush. It includes damper making, sampling billy tea, a guided bushwalk, investigating fresh water ponds and planting native trees as part of a revegetation project. Enjoy a day filled with opportunities for experiencing

Aussie tucker, spotting the laughing Australian bird and discovering a dry forest. Immerse yourself in the bush. The day includes a very delicious morning tea and lunch.

Sustainability - Water Matters

This program involves a magical mystery tour of the water cycle and looks at catchment care and water conservation. Join us for a fun-filled day playing in the model catchment in the creek, dams, waterfalls and bubblers before exploring the catchment in the forest where we will do a spot of bird watching while on a forest walk. Not only will you understand how the water cycle works but you will have a complete immersion in the fauna and flora of the Australian Eucalyptus Forest. The guided walk explores the diversity in the forest.

A picnic lunch is provided around our picturesque dam with Anzac biscuits and lamingtons for morning tea.

Beach to Bush Full Day Program

Begin or end your day at the bush or beach. Explore the Aussie bush, make damper on an open fire before arriving at the Nudgee Beach foreshore for lunch and take a look at crabs and the mangroves. Depending on tides the day begins or ends at the beach or the bush. So spot the kookaburra, explore the forest, look for crabs and enjoy the mangroves.
