Nudgee Beach Environmental Education Centre (NBEEC) is situated in the suburb of Nudgee Beach, 19 km from the centre of Brisbane City. The area around Nudgee Beach includes the Bramble Bay section of the Moreton Bay Marine Park, with the Boondall Wetlands Reserve to the north and west, and the Kedron Brook Floodway and Brisbane Airport to the south. Learning experiences vary, with wetlands and marine environments and their catchments as the main focus. The program aims to support students, teachers and schools with real learning experiences in exciting and dynamic ways.

Estuarine Study Program

Come spend the morning walking on one of the Boondall Wetlands tracks, to identify six of the seven mangroves in Moreton Bay. Discover why mangroves are described as the oceans' nursery with crabs, crabs and more crabs. After morning tea we will use drama and props to understand mud crabs before handling the smaller hermit crabs in touch tanks. The afternoon is then spent on the beach looking for small creatures in the water pools and sand flats. (The order of this program may change due to tides).

Sustainable Fishing Full Day Program

Sustainable fishing focuses on human interaction with the marine environment and resultant impact. Students are coached in the skills required for fishing but more importantly the reasons for bag and size limits. The catch and release approach is strongly recommended to students. Students complete the experience with an increased awareness and appreciation of the marine environment and the need to manage our impact on it in a sustainable manner.

Beach To Bush Full Day Program

Begin or end your day at the bush or beach. Explore the Aussie bush, make damper on an open fire before arriving at the Nudgee Beach foreshore for lunch and take a look at crabs and the mangroves. Depending on tides the day begins either at the beach or the bush. So spot the kookaburra, explore the forest, look for crabs and enjoy the mangroves.
